State Road (SR) 934/NW 74 Street/W-E 21 Street From W 4 Avenue to E 4 Avenue

Project Identification Numbers: 443909-1-52-01

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a roadway project along SR 934/NW 74 Street/W-E 21 Street from W 4 Avenue to E 4 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Enhancing traffic signals
- Removing abandoned driveway
- Repaying and restriping the roadway
- Modifying the storm water drainage, manholes, and curb ramps
- Upgrading damaged sidewalks, pedestrian signing and pavement markings
- Upgrading vehicular and pedestrian signage
- Adding new pedestrian countdown signals and upgrading lighting at signalized crosswalks
- Realigning NW 74 Street northbound approach to provide proper sidewalk width at the southeast corner of E 3 Avenue
- Upgrading traffic light at the Palm Avenue intersection to implement flashing yellow leftturn signal

Work is expected to begin fall 2024 and last about one year. Please note that the construction start date and duration is subject to change.

POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be impacted.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

During construction, temporary lane closures during non-peak hours and detours may affect traffic. Pedestrian detours will be established with clear signage. Access to adjacent businesses and residences will be maintained.
