## FDOT COMPASS

FDOT is committed to ensuring that the state's infrastructure serves residents, businesses, and visitors, to meet their needs now and in the future. Key areas include safety, resiliency, supply chain, technology, and workforce development. The following benefits are included in this project:



### COMMUNITY

- Upgrading pedestrian crosswalks at the following intersections:
  - NW 135 Street and NW 27 Avenue
  - NW 135 Street and NW 30 Avenue
  - Opa-locka Boulevard and NW 27 Avenue
- Improving drainage along the project limits
- Upgrading pedestrian signage and signals

### SAFETY

- Shifting the westbound Opa-locka Boulevard entrance further west to enhance safety
- Adding school zone signage and pavement markings
- Upgrading pedestrian railing on northbound and southbound NW 27 Avenue adjacent to the Opa-locka Canal
- Reconstructing sidewalks and pedestrian ramps at various locations

### RESILIENCY

- Repaving and restriping to preserve the service life of the road
- Improving drainage in the area to prevent future system issues and enhance the existing conditions of the road

### SUPPLY CHAIN

- Adding an additional eastbound left turn at NW 135 Street and NW 27 Avenue to ensure traffic flow at the intersection

### TECHNOLOGY

- Adding vehicle detection video equipment for reliable monitoring of road traffic
- Installing pavement traffic detectors to identify vehicles when approaching the traffic light
- Installing countdown pedestrian signals at various locations

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects to the community. Temporary lane closures may affect traffic during non-peak hours. All detours will be established with clear signage. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
