The Florida Keys Overseas Heritage Trail will be closed during repaving operations. Detours will be in place.



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WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects to the community. Temporary lane closures may affect traffic during non-peak hours. All detours will be established with clear signage. Access to Bahia Honda State Park will be maintained.

The speed limit will be 45 mph throughout the project limits, reduced from 55 mph.
