

FACT SHEET State Road (SR) 9336/SW 392 Street From Everglades National Park to SR 5/US 1 FIN #: 445987-1-52-01, 445989-1-52-01, and 445992-1-52-01

OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a roadway project the week of November 27, 2023 along SR 9336/ SW 392 Street from Everglades National Park to SR 5/US 1, in Miami-Dade County.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Widening roadway and shoulders
- Installing new drainage structures
- Replacing expansion joints on bridges (3 bridges)
- Repairing damaged sidewalks
- Installing a new 12-foot shared-used path between NW 13 Avenue and NW 8 Avenue
- Upgrading existing bus stops
- Retrofitting light poles with LED bulbs between NW 6 Avenue and NW 3 Avenue
- Installing solar powered speed feedback signs

Travel lanes and sidewalks will be closed during non-peak hours on non-event days. Non-peak hours are:

<u>445987-1-52-01</u>: SR 9336/Ingraham Highway/SW 392 Street/SW 376 Street corridor from Everglades National Park to the SW 192 Avenue Intersection:

- There are no hourly limits
- Traffic will be managed by flagging operation

45989-1-52-01: SR 9336/ SW 392 Avenue from SW 376 Street to south of SW 344 Street:

- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., weekdays and weekends
- 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., weekdays and weekends

<u>445992-1-52-01</u>: SR 9336/ SW 344 Street/Palm Drive from SW 192 Avenue to SR 5/US 1:

- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., weekdays and weekends
- 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
