OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a roadway project the week of November 2, 2023 along SR 5/ Overseas Highway in Monroe County.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Widening and repaving of shoulders
- Side street reconstruction at Ocean Drive and Second Avenue
- Replacing guardrail
- Modifying some driveways
- Upgrading roadway signage and pavement markings
- Miscellaneous drainage improvements
- Landscape improvements

November 2023 — early 2025
