

OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a roadway project the week of November 1, 2023 along SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway over the Tea Table Relief Bridge in Monroe County.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

- Repairing the bridge deck
- Rehabilitating the bridge and repairing some elements
