The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a bridge project the week of February 13, 2023, along SR 5/US 1/Long Key Bridge (#900094) over the Long Key Channel (MM 64.0) in Monroe County.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

- Repairing the concrete bridge elements
- Replacing the bridge deck expansion joints
