State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Hwy from Mile Marker (MM) 19.4 to MM 19.8, MM 20.6 to MM 23.1, and MM 26.2 to MM 27.4

Pedestrians and motorists will benefit from traffic, roadway and trail upgrades. Benefits of this project include improvements for the Community, Safety, Resiliency and Workforce Development.



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

The week of Sunday, July 7, 2024, a temporary concrete barrier wall will be installed on the southbound side of SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway on Cudjoe Key, between Sawyer Drive and Conch Drive, to allow for construction activities in the area.

- Southbound traffic will shift into the center turning lane just past Blimp Road, near MM 21.4. This shift requires the temporary elimination of the southbound turn lanes onto both Sawyer Drive and Colson Drive.
- Vehicles exiting Colson Drive to travel south on SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway may prefer to use Sunny Lane to Sawyer Drive. Detour signage will be in place.
- Vehicles exiting Old State Road 4a to go north on SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway may prefer to use Blimp Road.
- The existing southbound temporary lane shift at approximately MM 22.6 remains in place, with southbound traffic shifted into the center of the road, and a single travel lane in each direction.

***Please note this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.**

LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION

Work will be done in phases to reduce any construction impacts. Lanes can be closed during the following hours:

- 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday - Thursday

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Lane closure information will be posted weekly on the department's website, www.southflroads.com.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The speed limit is reduced to 35 mph from approximately MM 20.5 to MM 23, and from MM 26.2 to MM 27. Lane widths will be reduced within the work zones where necessary.
