  - o Pedestrian ramps, detectable warning surfaces and safety guiderails

- Providing a more resilient infrastructure along SW 8 Street by improving the following:
  - o Repaving and restriping the roadway to preserve the service life of the road
  - o Reconstructing sidewalks at various locations

 Roadway safety improvements enhance supply chain efficiency by connecting communities and promoting sustainability in the transportation of goods

## **TECHNOLOGY**

- Providing technology that enhances safety and convenience for residents and visitors, including:

  - o Upgrading existing light poles with light-emitting diodes (LED) at various locations
