## **The Florida Department of Transportation Completes SR 934/NW 74 Street Roadway Project**

*From East of SR 826/Palmetto Expressway to NW 69 Avenue*

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has completed the State Road (SR) 934/NW 74 Street roadway project from East of SR 826/Palmetto Expressway to NW 69 Street in the Town of Medley. This 15-month project began in March 2023 and cost approximately \$3.7 million. FDOT and its contractor, Horizon Contractors, Inc., completed this project on schedule and within budget.

FDOT is committed to ensuring the State’s infrastructure serves residents, businesses, and visitors to meet their current and future transportation needs. Benefits of this project include: complete roadway reconstruction along SR 934/NW 74 Street; installation of new traffic signal mast arms and signage throughout the project corridor; reconstruction of concrete sidewalks, curb ramps, and curb and gutters; and installation of new stormwater drainage structures.
