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FDOT Golden Glades Interchange (GGI) Project Lane and Ramp Closures & Detours

Sunday, July 7 to Saturday, July 13

MIAMI, Fla. – As part of the ongoing interchange reconstruction work, contractors for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be implementing various roadway closures and detours. These closures will allow crews to perform bridge work, roadway paving, overhead sign removal and temporary concrete barrier wall installation.

Sunday, July 7 to Thursday, July 11 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

The ramp from northbound State Road (SR) 9A/I-95 to NW 167 Street will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Continue north on SR 9A/I-95 and take the ramp to SR 7/US 441/ NW 2 Avenue
- Turn left onto westbound NW 7 Avenue Extension
- Continue west for westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Exit at NW 12 Avenue and turn left onto southbound NW 12 Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound NW 167 Street and take the ramp for eastbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Exit at SR 826 Beaches for NW 167 Street

The ramp from northbound SR 9 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Go east on SR 916/NW 135 Street
- Take the ramp onto northbound SR 9A/I-95 for the Golden Glades Interchange

The ramp from northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Go south on SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound SR 916/NW 135 Street
- Take the ramp onto northbound SR 9A/I-95 for the Golden Glades Interchange

The northbound and southbound SR 9A/I-95 Express Lanes between NW 30 Street and NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive will be closed, and traffic will be directed to use the general purpose lanes along SR 9A/I-95.

Friday, July 12 and Saturday, July 13 between 11:59 p.m. and 7 a.m.:

All lanes along southbound SR 9A/I-95 will be closed at NW 159 Street and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Take the ramp to southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Continue south on SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound SR 916/NW 135 Street
- Take the ramp onto southbound SR 9A/I-95

Continuous closure:

NW 6 Avenue is closed between NW 151 Street and NW 162 Street while construction crews work on stormwater drainage improvements. Contractors for Florida Power & Light (FPL) and City of North Miami Beach are also performing utility work along NW 6 Avenue. A detour is in place for several months to complete this phase of work.

Drivers and pedestrians who want to go north onto NW 6 Avenue from the intersection of NW 151 Street and NW 6 Avenue will be detoured as follows:

- Go east along NW 151 Street
- Turn right onto southbound South Biscayne River Drive
- Take the third exit at the roundabout onto northbound North Miami Avenue
- Turn left onto northbound Memorial Highway, which converts to NW 2 Avenue
- Continue north along NW 2 Avenue to NW 165 Street

Drivers and pedestrians who want to go south onto NW 6 Avenue from the intersection of NW 165 Street and NW 2 Avenue will be detoured as follows:

- Continue south along NW 2 Avenue, which converts to Memorial Highway
- Turn right onto southbound North Miami Avenue
- Turn right onto northbound South Biscayne River Drive
- Turn left onto westbound NW 151 Street
- Continue west along NW 151 Street to NW 6 Avenue

These lane closures below will occur nightly as needed:

SR 9A/I-95 between SR 916/NW 135 Street and the Golden Glades Interchange

- At 9 p.m., one lane in both directions will be closed as needed.
- At 11 p.m., a second lane in both directions will be closed as needed.

SR 826/Palmetto Expressway between NW 12 Avenue and NW 7 Avenue Extension

- At 9 p.m., one lane in both directions will be closed as needed.
- At 11 p.m., a second lane in both directions will be closed as needed.

SR 91/Florida's Turnpike between SR 860/NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive and SR 9A/I-95

• From 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., up to two lanes in both directions will be closed as needed.

Detours will be clearly marked. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
