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## FDOT to Host SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive Design Project Public Meeting

July 23, 2024

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a meeting, both in-person and virtually, for a roadway design project along State Road (SR) 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive from west of SW 92 avenue to SW 9100 block, starting at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, July 23, 2024.

Proposed improvements include: Modifying the median at SW 92 Avenue and SW 88 street

to an exclusive westbound left turn; removing left turn lane on SW 92 Avenue and providing a

right turn lane; adding a U turn only lane at the SW 9100 Block signalized intersection and installing a traffic light for a new lane; and repaving and restriping the road.

Construction is scheduled to start in early 2028 and last about four months. The preliminary construction cost is \$467,984.

The meeting will consist of a formal presentation followed by an open discussion. Staff will be available to answer questions in the order they are received and as time permits. If your question is not responded to during the meeting, a response will be provided in writing afterwards.
