## Roadway Reopened Along NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue at SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

**MIAMI, Fla.** – All northbound and southbound lanes and pedestrian access have been reopened along NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue at State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway. Work crews completed the first phase of emergency repairs due to the bridge being struck by a tractor trailer. One westbound travel lane and the outside shoulder remains closed along SR 826/Palmetto Expressway.

The second phase of repairs includes an around-the-clock weekend full closure of NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue at SR 826/Palmetto Expressway from Friday, September 27 at 9:30 p.m. until Monday, September 30 at 5 a.m.

Starting Monday, September 30, nightly detours will be in place between 9:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. along NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue at SR 826/Palmetto Expressway. This is not associated with the ongoing Golden Glades Interchange construction project.

Drivers traveling north along NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue are being detoured as follows:

- Turn left onto westbound NW 165 Street
- Turn right onto northbound NW 16 Court
- Turn right to access eastbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway or eastbound NW 167 Street
- Or turn left onto westbound NW 167 Street to access northbound NW 17 Avenue or westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

Drivers traveling south along NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue are being detoured as follows:

- Turn right onto westbound NW 167 Street
- Turn left onto southbound NW 17 Avenue
- Turn left to access eastbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

Westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway remains open. Updates will be provided as they become available.
