### **Closures of SR 836, I-95 and MacArthur Causeway**

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The closures noted below will be implemented to safely perform overhead bridge operations and scheduled roadway work.

#### **FULL CLOSURE OF State Road (SR) 836**

**THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 27, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28, SUNDAY, MARCH 2 THROUGH FRIDAY, MARCH 7** - All westbound lanes on SR 836 will be closed from NW 12 Avenue to NW 17 Avenue between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

- Drivers on eastbound SR 836 can:
  - Exit at the NW 17 Avenue South (Ballpark) ramp, then turn right at NW 17 Avenue
  - Turn left at NW 7 Street
  - Turn left at NW 12 Avenue to connect with eastbound SR 836 ramp
- Drivers on westbound SR 836 can:
  - Exit at the NW 12 Avenue ramp, then turn left on NW 12 Avenue
  - Turn right on NW 7 Street
  - Turn right on NW 27 Avenue and continue north to connect with the westbound SR 836 ramp

#### **NORTHBOUND Interstate 95 (I-95) RAMP TO WESTBOUND SR 836 DETOUR**

**SUNDAY, MARCH 2** - The northbound I-95 ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Enter the eastbound I-395 ramp
- Exit at NE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2B), then turn right on NE 2 Avenue
- Turn right on NE 11 Street
- Turn right on NE 1 Avenue to access westbound I-395 to continue onto westbound SR 836

#### **FULL CLOSURE OF WESTBOUND MACARTHUR CAUSEWAY AT BISCAYNE BOULEVARD AND THE DOWNTOWN RAMP TO WESTBOUND I-395**

**TUESDAY, MARCH 4 AND WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4** - All westbound MacArthur Causeway travel lanes will be closed at Biscayne Boulevard between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. for roadway work. Drivers can use the detour below and shown [HERE](#).

- Exit at Biscayne Boulevard, turn left at Biscayne Boulevard
- Turn right at NE 6 Street and follow detour signs to access I-95
- Continue west on NW 6 Street, turn left at NW 7 Avenue, then right at NW South River Drive
- Turn left at NW 7 Street, turn right at NW 17 Avenue to access westbound the SR 836 entrance ramp

**NOTE:** The North Miami Avenue ramp to westbound I-395 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. To view a map of the detour, click [HERE](#).

### **NORTHBOUND I-95 RAMP TO EASTBOUND I-395 DETOUR**

**THURSDAY, MARCH 6 AND FRIDAY, MARCH 7** - The northbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:

- Exit at the NW 2 Street ramp (Exit 2B)
- Continue north on NW 3 Avenue, then turn right on NW 8 Street
- Continue east on NW/NE 8 Street
- Turn left on Biscayne Boulevard to access A1A North/Miami Beach

### **SOUTHBOUND I-95 RAMP TO EASTBOUND I-395 CLOSURES**

**THURSDAY, MARCH 6 AND FRIDAY, MARCH 7** - The southbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:

- Continue south on I-95, exit at the NW 8 Street ramp (Exit 3B)
- Turn left on NW 8 Street, continue east on NW 8 Street
- Turn left at Biscayne Boulevard to access the A1A North/Miami Beach Ramp
