SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge Ramp to Northbound SR 9A/I-95 Closure Begins Sunday, July 21

MIAMI, Fla. – As part of the necessary ongoing rehabilitation work, contractors for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close the westbound ramp of State Road (SR) 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge to northbound Interstate 95 (I-95) at 10 p.m., Sunday, July 21 and detour traffic. The ramp will remain closed until Saturday, August 3.

The ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to southbound US 1 will reopen on Saturday, June 20.

During the closure, drivers going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go north on I-95 will be detoured onto SW 26 Road, then continue west and follow the signs to the northbound I-95 entrance ramp. Detours will also be established on South Miami Avenue and SW 25 Road, during this closure.

Please plan accordingly and expect heavy traffic and delays along the Rickenbacker Causeway and surrounding areas during these closures. Detours will be clearly marked. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
