Traffic shift on Westbound I-395

MIAMI, Fla. – On **WEDNESDAY MORNING, JULY 17 (THURSDAY MORNING, JULY 18 IS AN ALTERNATE DATE)**, all westbound Interstate 395 (I-395) travel lanes will be shifted to the left as shown [HERE](#) from east of North Bayshore Drive to Biscayne Boulevard. The shift is necessary to open a work zone to continue constructing one of the I-395 signature bridge arches.

To complete the shift, all westbound travel lanes on I-395 will be closed on **TUESDAY, JULY 16 (WEDNESDAY, JULY 17 IS AN ALTERNATE DATE)** at the Biscayne Boulevard exit ramp between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. to implement a traffic shift.

- Drivers heading north on I-95 can:
 - Exit at the Biscayne Boulevard ramp, then turn left on Biscayne Boulevard
 - Turn right at NE 6 Street
 - Turn right on NW 3 Avenue to access the northbound I-95 entrance ramp at NW 8 Street
- Drivers heading south on I-95 can:
 - Exit at the Biscayne Boulevard ramp, then turn left on Biscayne Boulevard
 - Turn right at NE 6 Street
 - Turn left at NW 3 Court to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp at NW 2 Street
- Drivers heading west on SR 836 can:
 - Exit at the Biscayne Boulevard ramp, then turn left on Biscayne Boulevard
 - Turn right at NE 6 Street
 - Turn left at NW 7 Avenue, go over the Miami River Bridge and turn right on NW South River Drive
 - Turn left on NW 7 Street, then turn right on NW 17 Avenue to connect with the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp

Please note this schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen conditions. The work is part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that is reconstructing the

I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge.
