FDOT is committed to ensuring the State's infrastructure serves residents, businesses, and visitors to meet their current and future transportation needs. Pedestrians and motorists will benefit from traffic, roadway and trail upgrades. Benefits of this project include improvements for the Community, Safety, Resiliency and Workforce Development.

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

A temporary concrete barrier wall will be installed the week of Sunday, October 6, 2024*, to allow for construction activities in the area. The wall will be located between Colson Drive and Conch Drive on the northbound side of SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway on Cudjoe Key.

- Northbound traffic will shift into the center turning lane just past Sawyer Road, near MM 21.2. This shift requires the temporary elimination of the southbound turn lanes onto both Sawyer Drive and Colson Drive.
- Vehicles exiting Colson Drive to travel south on SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway may prefer to use Sunny Lane to Sawyer Drive. Detour signage is in place.
- Vehicles exiting Old State Road 4a to go north on SR 5/US 1/ Overseas Highway may prefer to use Blimp Road.

*Please note this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.

LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION

Work will be done in phases to reduce construction impacts. Lanes may be closed during the following hours:

• 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday - Thursday

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Lane closure information will be posted weekly on the department's website, www.southflroads.com.



WHAT TO EXPECT

The speed limit is reduced to 35 mph from approximately MM 20.5 to MM 23, and from MM 26.2 to MM 27.4. Lane widths are reduced within the work zone as necessary.
