

ABOUT THE STUDY

Project Purpose

- Address the operational deficiencies to relieve current and anticipated future congestion along the SR 9A / I-95 corridor
- Preserve the operational integrity and regional functionality of SR 9A / I-95

Project Need

Capacity and Transportation Demand
Miami-Dade County's population and employment

are expected to grow by 27% and 29% from 2020-2050, further worsening SR 9A / I-95 congestion over time.

System Linkage

SR 9A / I-95 is a key interstate, connecting major urban areas and crucial for commuter and freight traffic statewide.

Emergency Evacuation

SR 9A / I-95 is vital for emergency evacuation and connects to three other key routes: SR 934/NW 79th Street, SR 924/NW 119th Street, and SR 922/NW 125th Street.
