The following closures will take place to perform these activities safely:

A single lane on eastbound SR 934/W/E 21 Street from west of Palm Avenue to just east of E 3 Avenue will be closed to perform drainage work. One lane will remain open for drivers at all times.

<u>Northeast Corner:</u> The right turn lane from westbound E 21 Street to northbound Palm Avenue, as well as a single right lane on northbound Palm Avenue will be closed.

<u>Southeast Corner:</u> The right turn lane from northbound Palm Avenue to eastbound E 21 Street, as well as a single right lane on eastbound E 21 Street adjacent to Orale Wey Restaurant, 2093 Palm Avenue, will be closed.

<u>Southwest Corner:</u> The right turn lane from eastbound W 21 Street to southbound Palm Avenue, as well as a single right lane on southbound Palm Avenue, adjacent to Marathon Gas Station, 2090 Palm Avenue, will be closed.

Northwest Corner: The right turn lane from southbound Palm Avenue to westbound W 21 Street, as well as a single right lane on westbound W 21 Street, will be closed.

Pedestrian and property access will always be maintained during construction. Be advised that parking will be temporarily eliminated where active work is taking place along the project limits
