SR 934/W/E 21 Street/NW 74 Street Closures Begin Tonight, February 14, 2025

At SR 934/W/E 21 Street and E 3 Avenue

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will implement lane closures on State Road (SR) 934/W/E 21 Street at E 3 Avenue as part of the ongoing roadway project between E 4 Avenue to W 4 Avenue. The closures will take place on weekends from **Friday, February 14 through Monday, March 3**, for the installation of new drainage structures. The closure will begin on Fridays, from 9 p.m. and conclude on Mondays at 6 a.m.

At least one lane on E 21 Street will remain open at all times. Access to businesses and side streets will be maintained. The speed limit throughout the work zone will remain 35 miles per hour.



Please follow the posted detour signage and note that drivers may experience delays while traveling through the area. This schedule may change due to weather or unexpected conditions.

Remember, wearing a safety belt is the single most effective way to protect people and reduce fatalities in motor vehicle crashes. Always be safe and remain alert while driving in construction zones.
