



## Wrong-Way Driving Initiative Phase 2 Paving Operations Begin August 18, 2025

*At 12 exit ramp locations throughout Miami-Dade County*

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will implement overnight closures and detours at 12 exit ramps throughout Miami-Dade County as part of the ongoing Wrong-Way Driving Initiative Phase 2 project. These closures are necessary to safely perform paving activities and will take place nightly from **Monday, August 18, through Sunday, September 7**, between **9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**, throughout this period.

To help drivers navigate the area safely, detour routes have been established for each off-ramp location. Motorists should anticipate the following closures, the week of Monday, August 18 through Friday, August 22, 2025.

### **Southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway to W 68 Street/NW 122 Street**

**When:** Monday night, August 18, and Tuesday night, August 19

**Time:** 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- Continue southbound on SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Take the exit to NW 103 Street
- Turn right and continue straight on NW 103 Street
- Turn right on W 24 Avenue
- Continue straight to access W 68 Street/NW 122 Street and W 20 Avenue

### **Southbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway to NW 74 Street**

**When:** Wednesday night, August 20, and Thursday night, August 21

**Time:** 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- Continue southbound on SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Take the exit to NW 58 Street
- Turn left and continue straight on NW 58 Street
- Turn left on NW 72 Avenue
- Continue straight to access NW 74 Street

Additional exit ramp closures will occur throughout Miami-Dade County during this period. Please be advised that construction alerts and detour information will be distributed **weekly**.

Detours will be clearly marked. **Please follow all posted signage and note that the schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.**

Remember, wearing a safety belt is the single most effective way to protect people and reduce fatalities in motor vehicle crashes. Always be safe and remain alert while driving in construction zones.
