State Road (SR) 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road Corridor Wide Construction Update

Below is a list of ongoing construction activities and lane closure information for each project segment.

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Segment Two: From east of NW 107 Avenue to east of NW 116 Way

- Performing roadway widening and drainage installation work along Okeechobee Rd, NW 116 Way/Hialeah Gardens Blvd, NW S River Dr, NW 121 Way and Frontage Rd
- Installing the following:
 - Bridge Walls
 - Protective outfall gate for wildlife
 - New pump station on NW 121 Way
 - New flow meter at NW 116 Way
 - Concrete pavement along Okeechobee Rd
 - Foundations for under deck lighting
 - Closed Circuit Television Camera pole station
- Pile driving operations and bridge construction at:
 - Hialeah Gardens Blvd just north of Frontage Road
 - Okeechobee Rd and NW 98 Ave
 - Okeechobee Rd and NW 114 St
 - Okeechobee Rd at the NW 116 Way intersection
 - NW 121 Way - pile driving operations

General Lane Closures

- A single lane closure along NW 116 Way from Frontage Rd to W 68 St, in both the northbound and southbound direction.
- A single lane closure along Okeechobee Rd from NW 92 Ave to NW 107 Ave, in both the northbound and southbound direction.

Closures will take place Monday through Saturday during the following hours:

- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on weekdays
- 11 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. on weekends

Continuous Lane Closures/Traffic Shifts

- Travel lanes are reduced to two lanes in each direction along the NW 116 Way bridge between Okeechobee Road and NW South River Drive.
- Traffic lanes are reduced to two lanes in each direction along Okeechobee Road from east of NW 107 Avenue to NW 92 Avenue.
- Full closure of the NW 121 Way Bridge

FULL CLOSURE OF SR 25/US 27/OKEECHOBEE ROAD BETWEEN NW 98 AVENUE AND NW 116 WAY

Starting at 9 p.m. on Friday, July 12, 2024, the southbound/eastbound lanes along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road will be closed between NW 98 Avenue and Hialeah Gardens Boulevard/NW 116 Way. The lanes will reopen to traffic by 5 a.m. on Saturday, July 13, 2024. This closure will allow the contractor to install Intelligent Transportation System structures in the area. Please note, this is a nighttime operation and construction noise is expected. The following detour will be implemented:

- Motorists heading southbound/eastbound along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road will be detoured to make a left at the NW 98 Avenue ramp (under the overpass) make a right at Frontage Road, make a right at Hialeah Gardens Boulevard/NW 116 Way, and make a left at SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road to continue heading southbound/eastbound along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road.

Detours will be clearly marked and access to neighborhoods will be maintained at all times. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.



TRAFFIC SHIFT ALONG SR 25/US 27/OKEECHOBEE ROAD BETWEEN NW 107 AVE AND NW 104 AVE

Starting Friday, July 12 crews will begin shifting travel lanes onto the new concrete pavement along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road between NW 107 Avenue and NW 104 Avenue. FDOT and Florida's Turnpike Enterprise are working together to ensure a smooth roadway transition between the two project segments.



ONGOING: NIGHTLY CLOSURE OF NORTHBOUND LANES AT THE SR 25/US 27/OKEECHOBEE ROAD AND NW 116 WAY INTERSECTION

The northbound lanes at the SR 25/Okeechobee Rd and NW 116 Way intersection are closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. This allows crews to continue pile driving efforts for the construction of the overpass.
