State Road (SR) 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road Corridor Wide Construction Update

Below is a list of ongoing construction activities and lane closure information for each project segment.

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Segment One: From the Broward County Line to west of Florida's Turnpike

- Finalizing the following activities:
 - Testing the Intelligent Transportation System fiber optic cables
 - Lighting and signalization
 - Applying pavement marking and installing signage
- Preparations to close out the project. *Please note, this project is scheduled for completion this fall 2023.*

General Lane Closures

- Temporary single lane closures along Okeechobee Rd from the Broward County Ln to north of NW 154 St, in both directions, as needed.
- Temporary single lane closures along Okeechobee Rd south of NW 154 St, in both directions, between the nonpeak hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Temporary shoulder closures along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Rd, in both directions, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Nighttime construction activities are taking place from 6 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- Intermittent nightly detours at Krome Ave for paving operations

Segment Two: From east of NW 107 Avenue to east of NW 116 Way

- Performing roadway widening and drainage installation work along Okeechobee Rd, NW 116 Way/Hialeah Gardens Blvd, NW S River Dr, NW 121 Way and Frontage Rd
- Installing the following:
 - Concrete pavement along Okeechobee Rd
 - Sewer pipes
 - Bridge walls
 - Permanent light poles, sidewalk and guardrail along Hialeah Gardens Blvd
 - Sidewalk and curb at Frontage Road and NW 122 St
 - Permanent signs along Frontage Rd from NW 116 Way to NW 103 Ave
 - Signalization and signage foundations along Frontage Rd
 - Intelligent Transportation Systems between Okeechobee and Frontage Rd
 - Structural beams as part of the second-level overpass
- Driveway reconstruction along Hialeah Gardens Boulevard
- Clearing the area for upcoming work at NW S River Dr and NW 121 Way
- Forming the deck on the east side of the NW 116 Way Bridge
- Pile driving operations and bridge construction at:
 - Hialeah Gardens Blvd just north of Frontage Road
 - Okeechobee Rd and NW 98 Ave
 - Okeechobee Rd and NW 114 St
 - Okeechobee Rd at the NW 116 Way intersection
 - NW 116 Way Bridge

General Lane Closures

- A single lane closure along NW 116 Way from Frontage Rd to W 68 St, in both the northbound and southbound direction.
- A single lane closure along Okeechobee Rd from NW 92 Ave to NW 107 Ave, in both the northbound and southbound direction.
- Travel lanes are reduced to two lanes in each direction along the bridge between Okeechobee Road and NW South River Drive. All travel lanes are shifted to the newly construction west side of the bridge.
- Traffic shift along Okeechobee Rd from NW 92 Ave to NW 99 Ave. Travel lanes are reduced to two lanes in both directions.

Closures will take place Monday through Saturday during the following hours:

- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on weekdays
- 11 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. on weekends

UPCOMING TRAFFIC PATTERN

Full Closure of Okeechobee Rd east of NW 116 Way

The southbound lanes along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road will be closed nightly from Sunday, October 22 to Thursday, October 26, 2023, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Please note, travel lanes will reopen daily. This closure will allow crews to safely install structural beams as part of the second-level overpass. During this time, motorists will be detoured through NW South River Drive. Details below:

- Motorists traveling southbound/eastbound on SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road, will be directed to make a right turn on NW 116 Way, a left-on NW South River Drive, a left-on NW 105 Way, and a right to continue to southbound/eastbound SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road.
